Cooper Mountain is a pioneering winery in Oregon's Willamette Valley, established on the outskirts of Portland in the late 1970's. The winery began as and remains a family endeavor, with two generations of the Gross family guiding Cooper Mountain. Since 2014 winemaker Gilles de Domingo has been overseeing all winemaking.

Certified Organic, Biodynamic. Elevation 300ft. *Old Vines Vineyard* Saum soil, planted in 1978, Willamette Valley AVA. Certified Organic, Biodynamic. Elevation 500ft.
