## Tocai Friulano

We planted 2.5 acres of Tocai Friulano at our warmer Johnson School vineyard in 2004. The esoteric grape of Tocai Friulano is also known as Sauvignon Vert, cousin to much more prolific Sauvignon Blanc and it's a quirky varietal we love. The wine is an aromatic treat with peaches, mineral, citrus, and a hint of spice. The rich, dry palate exhibits honeysuckle and cool melon and finishes with nicely zippy acids. A perfect wine partner for shellfish and curry. Or it's delightful on its own. 90 pts

## Old Vines Chardonnay

On the south western facing slopes of an extinct volcano in the late 1970's founders and pioneers Bob and Corrine Gross first married chardonnay to the soils of Cooper Mountain. The vines have seen the evolution of the Oregon, have welcomed a new generation, decades of stories, visitors from around the globe, yet they stay rooted to place. If these vines could talk! Crème brulee, hazelnuts, lemon zest and mineral thread and create a ethereal expression of restraint and place. Creamy pasta and seafood compliment this wine. 91 pts

This wine reflects decades of hard work, love, and careful attention. The fruit for our Pinot Gris comes from the first vines planted on Cooper Mountain. Shallow volcanic soil cause these vines to work extra hard, resulting in wonderful concentration of fruit and flavors that include the very minerals that make up the soil. Drier and more serious, this Pinot Gris demands creamy mushroom dishes or grilled salmon.

## Aged-Balsamic Vinegar

Following the 2000 crush at Cooper Mountain Vineyards 150 gallons of a blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir juice with a high concentration of sugar was placed in stainless steel tanks and brought to boil for almost three days. It is during this phase that the yeast transformed the sugar and produced alcohol. The result: balsamic vinegar. After the boiling process the product went into the first of a series of barrels for the aging process. The barrels were made by the well known manufacturer of balsamic barrels F. Renzi of Modena, Italy. Five different wood barrels were used during aging: Oak, Chestnut, Mulberry, Cherry, and Robinia. -Domestic Barrel-Aged Balsamic Vinegar -Limited Quantity -Made with organic and biodynamic® grapes
