



## 2021 Cooper Mountain Pinot Noir

### People:

Cooper Mountain is a pioneering winery in Oregon's Willamette Valley, established on the outskirts of Portland in the late 1970's. The winery began as and remains a family endeavor, with two generations of the Gross family guiding Cooper Mountain. Since 2004 winemaker Gilles de Domingo has been overseeing all winemaking.

#### Johnson School Vineyard

Laurelwood soil, planted in 1999, Chehalem Mountains AVA.  
Certified Organic, Biodynamic. Elevation 400ft.

#### Meadowlark Vineyard

Willakenzie soil, planted in 1982, Willamette Valley AVA.  
Certified Organic, Biodynamic. Elevation 300ft.

#### Old Vines Vineyard

Saum soil, planted in 1978, Willamette Valley AVA.  
Certified Organic, Biodynamic. Elevation 500ft.

#### Corrine Vineyard

Jory soil, planted in 1989, Chehalem Mountains AVA.  
Certified Organic, Biodynamic. Elevation 400ft.
